FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Who is eligible to apply?

The award is open to all active participating members of the C.M.A.S., immediately proceeding the current membership year. Applicants must have maintained that status for at least 2 consecutive years.

Who will determine the winner of the CMAS Bursary Award?

Our panel of jurors are all members of the SCMA. They all work within the Saskatchewan country music industry. All jurors are required to sign a conflict of interest agreement.

What happens if I receive the CMAS Bursary award?

We will be awarding one (1) deserving country music participating CMAS Member a \$1000.00 Bursary Award! The CMAS Bursary award winner will be announced on February 6th, 2010 at the CMAS Curling Bonspiel Steak Dinner Fundraiser.

If the CMAS Bursary award winner is unable to attend the February 6th Steak Dinner Fundraiser, a letter will then be sent to them.

Can I fax in my application?

No. All applications must be submitted in its original form. They can be mailed or dropped off at the address on the CMAS Bursary Award Application. All applications must be received no later than January 22, 2010.

Am I able to reapply?

Yes. You can reapply for the following year's CMAS Bursary award. CMAS Bursary award winners may also reapply for the CMAS Bursary award for the following year..
